## CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Players must be registered with NSBA as a full or affiliate member. They must provide Photo ID when requested by NSBA staff. A current passport or driver's license is an acceptable form of Photo ID.
2. All Teams/Players/Members are expected to read and understand with the NSBA By-laws.
3. Norths News is the principal means of communication to members and is sent weekly to your nominated email. It is your responsibility to read the information contained in Norths News.
4. All players must comply with the NSBA By-laws and Competition Rules.
5. Team Grading is the sole responsibility of NSBA.
6. NSBA retains the right not to accept any nomination.

## Introduction New By-laws

New By-laws introduced and applied at the commencement of the Senior Hoops 2011-12 Competition. These new extracts will be incorporated into the current byelaws on the web site.

### New Extracts

**1<sup>st</sup> - Senior game forfeit fine \$90.00 for all divisions.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> - New By-Laws – Objects thrown at roof**

If in the opinion of an NSBA official (GSC, referee or member of staff) any person (player, coach, spectator, visitor) who attends an NSBA event and intentionally throws, kicks or in some way directs a basketball or any other object at a light, light cover, light fitting, light support, ceiling, other overhead fixture or venue structure, will be asked to leave the stadium and will not be permitted to enter any NSBA venue for a period

of seven (7) calendar days. For a player or coach this will be regarded as a technical dismissal. The ejected person must immediately comply with the instruction to leave the premises. The normal appeal process applies.

**3<sup>rd</sup> - "A fill in player to participate on up to two occasions for the same team per season".**

#### **4<sup>th</sup> - Player Playing Multiple Teams per Competition**

Bye-law 3.1 states that:

- a. a player can play at any level higher or lower than their nominated team's grade.
- b. no team can comprise of more than two players from a higher grade.
- c. the higher division is the player's first nominated team.

Notes:

- a. Teams found violating this rule will have the results from the matches recorded as 20 – 0 loss as a result of a technical forfeit with no fines or loss of competition points imposed.
- b. Teams found to be in breach of this bye-law are to be notified that they are in violation of our bye-laws and they will be given a grace period of three weeks in order for them to recruit new players so that they are no longer violating the bye-laws. Should the issue not be resolved within the specified grace period the team would be declared "not eligible" for the playoffs and the team are not eligible to receive the Exclusive Nomination Period and their team nomination is to be treated like a new team.

For the time being this bye-law is to be applied only to our men's competition until such time that the depth of our female teams has improved as such a move would currently be of detriment to our female competition.
