# **CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION**

1. Players must be registered with NSBA as a full or affiliate member and must provide photo Id when requested by staff. E.g. Passport or another acceptable form of Photo ID.
2. All players must comply with the NSBA By-laws and Competition Rules.
3. Team Grading is the sole responsibility of NSBA.
4. NSBA retains the right not to accept any nomination.

## **JUNIOR COMPETITION FORMAT**

### **Venues**

- North Sydney Indoor Sports Centre (NSISC), 36 Hume Street, Crows Nest
- Willoughby Leisure Centre (WLC), Small Street, Willoughby

### **Men & Women's Divisions**

- U14 (must not turn 14 during calendar year 2012)
- U16 (must not turn 16 during calendar year 2012)
- U18 (must not turn 18 during calendar year 2012)

### **Scheduling of Games**

The following is a general guide for the scheduling of games for each age group. The amount of teams accepted into the competition will determine the venue for each division.

#### **THURSDAYS**

- Games at WLC
- U18's Men
- 7.30pm - 11pm

#### **FRIDAYS**

- Games at NSISC & WLC
- U14's, U16's, U18's
- 5pm - 11pm
- NSBA has access to six courts – four @ NSISC and two @ WLC;  
Under 14's play between 5.00pm and 8.20pm  
Under 16's play between 5.00pm and 11.00pm  
Under 18's play between 8.20pm and 11.00pm

# **JUNIOR REP PLAYERS DEFINITIONS & BYE LAWS**

## **Representative Player Definition**

- A Representative Player is a player selected to represent their Association in any BNSW sanctioned competition.
- Representative Player status is maintained for any NSBA domestic competition for that calendar year.

## **Extract from current NSBA Bye Laws**

Page 4, 3.2 Juniors

- a) All NSBA representative players must play in the Associations' Domestic competition
- b) A team entered with three or more representative players playing in the same age group as their representative team must play in a Diamond League where offered.
- c) If a team is over the limit of representative players and does not wish to participate in the Diamond League, they can either play up an age group, or remain in their correct age group but shall not be eligible for playoffs.

U18's do not have a Diamond League - teams which are deemed over the limit of Representative players will play Division One in their age group if there are two or more grades.

## **Priority Renomination for Existing and Graduating Teams**

Returning junior teams or those graduating from the current U13 competition will be guaranteed a place in Competition One provided that a completed nomination form has been returned to NSBA by Monday 12th December 2011.

Returning teams that fail to nominate by Monday 12th December will still have the opportunity to participate in the competition but will no longer receive priority over new nominations.

Successful nominations, (other than returning and graduating teams nominating prior to the cut-off date) will be decided on the following criteria;

- Number of spaces available in your nominated division
- When the completed nomination form was received by NSBA
