Criteria for Induction into NSBA's Hall of Fame

Below is an extract from the NSBA Constitution, setting out the criteria for induction into the Hall of Fame:

Criteria for Induction to the Hall of Fame

6.3 To be selected for induction into NSBA's Hall of Fame, a person must meet the following criteria, subject to the criteria of Clause 6.1:

- (1) Have made
 - (a) An outstanding contribution; or
 - (b) A valuable contribution over a minimum period of eight years

That is of a volunteer nature, towards one of more aspects of Association activity that could include, but are not limited to, playing, coaching, refereeing, committee or Board membership or sponsorship, but does not preclude a person who is paid for their services.

- (2) Be a positive role model of sportsmanship and exemplify strong support for the values of the Norths Community.
